20 ft x 40 ft; electric and water access nearby.

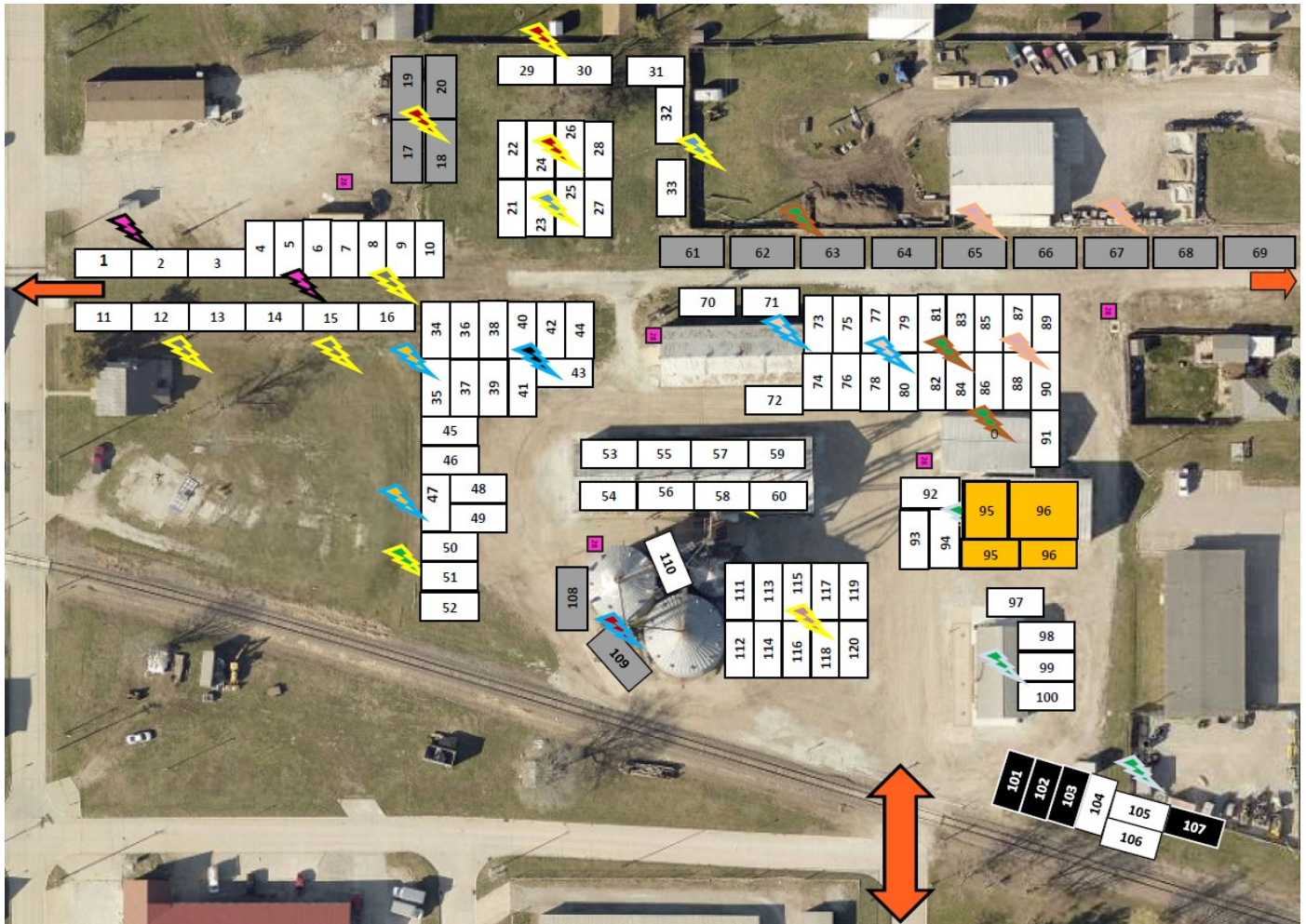
#### Regular Lot Non-Power (Black)

### PARKING AND TRAILER INFORMATION

- The first parking pass is \$50. Each additional pass is \$100 because space is limited. A purchased pass will be placed as close to the campsite as practical, but adjacent parking is not guaranteed.
- Free street parking and paid parking at neighboring businesses and homes may be available. Follow all local parking regulations.
- Complimentary trailer parking may be available inside SFG buildings as space permits, but it is not guaranteed. Reservations are not accepted; parking is strictly on a first-come, first-served basis. All trailers must be removed by the Saturday of the 410 Nationals unless prior alternative arrangements are officially made.

Anyone who alters a campsite boundary may be permanently banned from the facility.                                                                                               |
